Using Risk to Set Priorities and Drive Change

Founded in 2005 just outside Portland, Oregon and shaped by the vision of its President & CEO Travis Knight, LAIKA is a studio that combines a classic commitment to artistry and cinematic crafts with a delight in innovation and cutting-edge techniques. The studio's first films: Coraline (2009), ParaNorman (2012), The Boxtrolls (2014), Kubo and the Two Strings (2016), and Missing Link (2019) were all nominated for the Academy Award® for Outstanding Animated Feature.

Kubo and the Two Strings won the BAFTA Award for Best Animated Film and received an additional Oscar® nomination for Visual Effects. Missing Link was awarded the Golden Globe® for Best Animated Film. LAIKA was also awarded a Scientific and Technology Oscar® plaque in 2016 for its innovation in 3D printing.

LAIKA is currently in production on its next animated film, Wildwood. The studio is developing the animated feature films The Night Gardener, from an original idea by Bill Dubuque, creator of the hit series Ozark, and Piranesi, based on the NYT bestselling novel by Susanna Clarke. LAIKA has launched a Live Action subsidiary with a range of projects in development including a feature film based on the action thriller novel Seventeen by screenwriter John Brownlow.

HSE at LAIKA's stop-motion animation studio focuses on managing risks associated with various aspects of the filmmaking process, including visual effects work, equipment operation, and extensive fabrication. This session will discuss how to identify risks and how to prioritize risk reduction efforts, drive them to completion, and validate their efficacy. It will also focus on the importance of communication and collaboration among crew members and will cover compliance with industry regulations and standards, as well as ways to promote a safety culture throughout your organization. Joseph Henrich is the Health, Safety and Environmental Supervisor for LAIKA. Joseph holds a Bachelor of Science in Occupational Health and Safety and is a BSCP Certified Safety Professional. 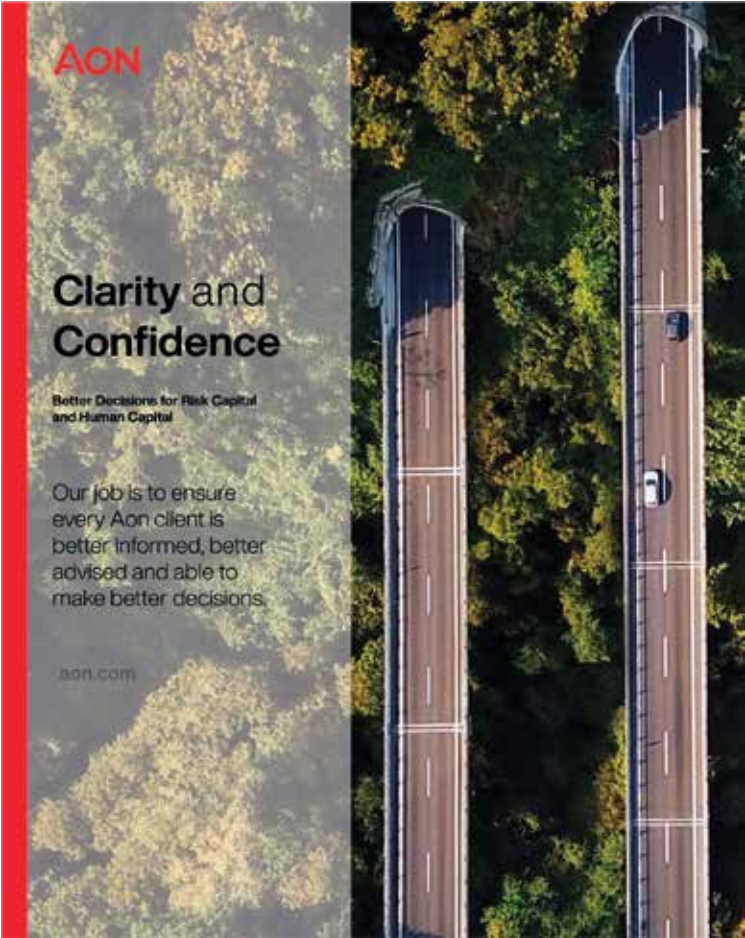

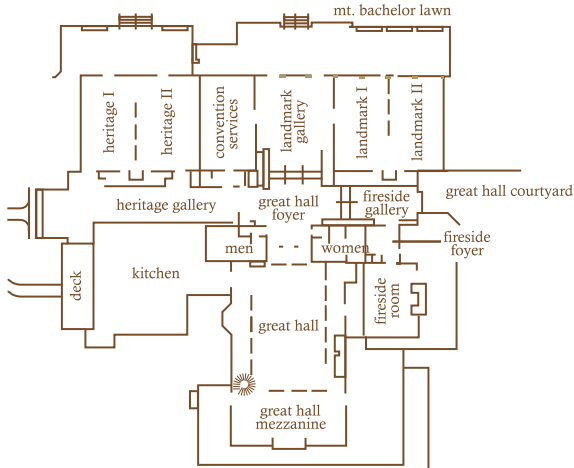

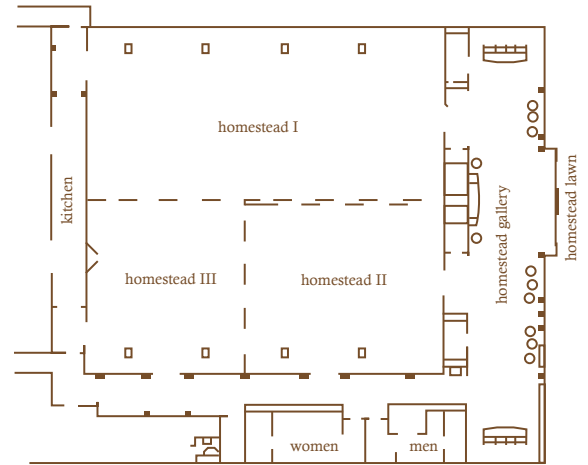
